

Alabama Counties 1860



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Copies of the military service record cards and original documents on the next few pages are exact duplicates of those on file at the National Archives in Washington, DC. At the end of the war, all available Confederate records were taken to the U. S. Adjutant General's Office in Washington and in 1903 the National Archives began the task of compiling the service records of every man who served. It was completed in the mid 1930's. Each time a soldier's name appeared on any type of record, a card was made indicating the type and date of the record and the information found concerning the man himself. These cards were placed in his file, along with any original documents pertaining to him, and recorded on microfilm tapé. The pension records, if any, are usually obtained from the archives department of the state in which the veteran or his widow were residents at the time of application for a pension.
