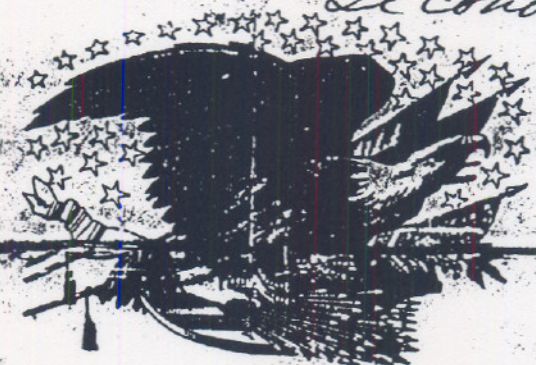

Know ye, That John T. Vardiman  
Sergeant of Captain Robert H. Armstrong's  
Company (I.) 6th Regiment of Kentucky Infantry  
VOLUNTEERS who was enrolled on the 14th day of October  
one thousand eight hundred and 61 to serve 3 years  
during the war, is hereby Discharged from the service of the United States  
this 31st day of December 1864 at Nashville  
Tennessee by reason of expiration of term of service  
(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)

Said John T. Vardiman is 23 years of age,  
5 feet 7 inches high, fair complexion, blue eyes,  
dark hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a farmer  
Given at Nashville Tenn this thirty first day of  
December 1864

22- This sentence will be erased should there be anything  
in the conduct or physical condition of the soldier  
rendering him unfit for the Army
