Beautiful day I took a walk around the  
country of about 4 miles wrote to Sig  
Collins. had dress parade and the Boys  
got contrary and got up out of Bed and  
smoked and Ranged till 12 o'clock

May 16 Tues

Myself and 7 Privs for Picket 2 Corporals  
Battle + Meredith we had a range at  
Breakfast about Snakes went to Picket  
with Capt Brown on the pike between  
Camp + City I was Supernumery  
Recd a letter from 2 Johnson

May 17 Wed

Came off of Picket Kiss got our Breakfast  
Joe Holmes offered me money to Buy a can of  
milk, wrote to Little Bro Johnny + George  
sent them 2 rups.

May 18 1865 Thurs

Kiss went to town Rained part of the day  
I wrote 2 letters for J Bremer one to M.B.  
and one to 2 Wilson drained 2 days  
soft Bread

May 19 Fri

in camp had Brigade inspection viewed  
knapsack inside  
Rained all night hand washed



3 or 4 Budge's away between Louisville  
and Nashville

May 20 Sat

I went to town on a pass. Wrote to Sister Mollie  
at the Christian Commission in town. Went all  
over town with Kim Stuck + Kim Bryfford and  
August. Came back at dusk. Bottle got  
my supper.

May 21 Sun

Policed at Revellie John Swaynie tied  
up for getting tight and didn't get out at  
Roll call. Had camp inspection. Had  
church afternoon. Rained most of the night.

May 22 Mon

Morning dawned fair. In camp all day  
done nothing. Charles estimated for  
clothing for next month.

May 23 Tues

Roman ranged with one of 41 <sup>about</sup> raids  
~~about~~ morning dawned fair with every  
sign of a nice day. Had drill in afternoon.  
Kiss + Haney + Bottle + Slusher + D. Rokker  
missed drill + was put on extra duty if it  
Suavely + Burton had a fight fell out about  
playing cards. Suavely threw him + Burton  
toned him. Suavely said he would quit if  
Burton would.



May 24 Wed

Nice day. Detail for 9 men, for Pickett  
Kiss was on out of our mess. Had a fight  
at General Mornir 2 of company D. Spencer  
was one of them he got took down  
Roman done nothing with them  
Burton & Sweeney made up & played wker  
together again

May 25 Thurs

Wet dreary day in forenoon afternoon  
we drilled Lt Harmon and another Lt  
Came to our camp with their women  
Read our first mail since Friday last  
I read a letter from A. A. P.

May 26 Fri

Morning cloudy and cool Kesting on extra  
dudy drilled I read a letter from  
Brother John Read Orders for all Regts  
whos time didn't expire before 31st of  
October to make out Pay Rolls. Roman said  
he heard we would be moved out inside  
of 10 days

May 27 Sat

Morning dawns fair. wrote a letter for  
J Reed and one to Bro John and one  
to A. A. P. and one to John Mc Kewey and  
one to Louis Powell. Read a letter from J Johnson.  
Wrote one for Bruce



May 28 Sun

In camp. I was not very well my back hurt me. wrote a letter for O Coblenz all sorts of Rumors afloat I had dress Parade. Genl Willick came back the Bayshires him all through the Brigade

May 29 Mon

drilled all day. I was excused by Chas on account of Pain in my back dry day

May 30 Tues

drilled forenoon and afternoon. I didn't drill. I wrote 2 letters for J Reel one to Callie Curtis at Vandalia and one to Charlotte Rausley.

May 31 Wed

Beautiful day but warm, drilled I was for extra duty but Glad Shanks on the Guard. Woodhull came to see us C Bush Brother in law from Dayton had a great chat with him

June 1 Thurs

Beautiful day but warm

it was a day of humiliation throughout the U.S.A. 3 Corporals and 9 men detailed for Picket I was one of the No Brewery came up. Depkat came to see us from Dayton went to club on Picket at night all of us



June 2 Fri

Came off of Picket went down and took a swim. Read our muster out Rolls at 2 P.M. Officers all busy all evening making out our muster out Rolls. Wrote to Sister Jennie. 1st Bregd had a torch Light Possession.

June 3 Sat

Officers at work all day at muster out Rolls. Warm Sultry day myself and Joe Bain and J. Reel went a Squirrel Hunting didn't kill any. Killed a Large snake. Wrote to Sister Jennie.

June 4 Sun 1867

Warm day. Chas Reuch Sam Parker and Pritz & Capt worked all day on muster out Rolls. I helped Joe Holmes to make out his in afternoon. We made out 4 on one side.

June 5 Mon

a very warm day I helped J. Holmes to finish his Rolls. worked all day for Holmes at Rolls.

June 6 Tues

Very warm day unfortable warm I helped Joe Holmes to finish his Rolls, we finished at 2 P.M. Bowman examed joes and said they were all Right. He liked mine Bully and said I should help Bregle to finish his. Wrote a letter for J. B. Reel.



June 7 wed

Read a letter from D P. In camp all day. Helped to finish Druggles muster rolls myself & C & David & Rhore myself. J & R & S R wrote at night. Went swimming afternoon. myself & Reel & Meredith run round at night heading.

June 8 Thurs 1865

Mustered out of U.S.A. at one P.M. myself & D Rohrer and Swuler & Kuhlman went hunting. Shot mark till all our ammunition was gone. Bowman went to get transportation but didn't.

June 9 Fri

Very warm day. I wrote 2 let for B Reel to give J Burton to go home. I wrote to Bro Jno for last army letter. drew 3 days rations. Read orders to go at midnight myself J B Reel and St Brown.

June 10 Sat

Reveille at one. Some of Boys didn't get to sleep. Was intoxicated all night. the Bay yelled to all Eternity when gun cell blowed. Left Nashville at 10 a.m.

June 11 Sun

Arrived at Louisville 1 o'clock at night. took Breakfast at Soderstrom's. Took the boat, run all day and night. Some of the Boys got very full.



June 12 Mon  
Tired up in the morning a while on account  
of the fog Pulled out at 6 o'clock A.M  
Passed several Boat loads of Sunday School  
celebrations. arrived at Cincinnati at  $\frac{1}{2}$   
past 10 A.M. Gov Anderson made a speech  
to us in Dept then came to camp with us  
at camp <sup>near</sup> Dennison O.

June 13 Tues  
at camp Dennison Ohio Turned over our  
guns and Equipments all  
Signed Pay Rolls Wm Jauner came  
to us to get his Pay

June 14 Wed  
at camp Dennison Ohio not very well all day  
was up in line in the evening and had  
order read to us and old man Baine made a  
small speech to us myself + Drewry +  
Dunler + Capt Brown went swimming

June 15 Thurs  
Paid off at 10 o'clock A.M took the  
cars at 2 o'clock I bought 2 shirts  
and a pair of shoes at camp Dennison  
arrived at Dayton at  $\frac{1}{2}$  past 6 P.M. was  
marched to court house there Chas  
Anderson made us a speech then took  
our supper at Phillip Hall I got a Bug +  
Wm Best came out with me



June 16 Fri

at Home all day came to Lockville in  
afternoon wrote to Brother John in the  
evening

June 17 Sat

Went to town with John Rohrer and came out  
at 4 P. M. Went out in woods in afternoon  
I said Isaac Wilson & wife came down  
me + Isaac went to Williamssons got  
some Ale came back

June 18 Sun

at Home sick all day Lily and Molly  
went to Chambersberg

June 19 Mon

Myself and Uncle Henry went over to see  
Jae Louiry came round by the mills +  
Herchebrockis came back + me + Georgy  
went to Todlgate went out in evening  
and shot a squirrel

June 20 Tues

Went to Dayton and took the cars for  
Tipp at Tip all day with C & Rohrer

Excerpts from J. S. White memorandum

- April 1, 1894 - nice day. Harry & family + George and  
Hattie come up yesterday. Killed wild goose.
- April 22 - wheat has about half in the country  
examined out. Some all gone will put it in corn. It  
has been the windiest spring ever known in Kans.
- May 12 - I finished my stone still.
- May 26 - Mable and Blanche, Dick & I went for a  
run away with Frank Coit + Kate Finckrope.
- June 2 - County papers, gubernatorial election  
& delegates to State and to Congressional convention.
- July 4 - Frank + Mervin + Hat + George went to  
Abilene. The rest of us staid at home and worked.
- July 4 - Frank + Jewa was married.
- July 12 - I finished laying my corn by.
- July 15 - We all went to Harrys had ice cream.
- Oct 11 - James and Eura Graham and Major  
McC Kenley come out to see us.
- Dec 25 - James Haley + Mervin White had married.
- Jan 2 1895 - Sister Martha Weir come to see us. Her  
Cyus + Murray Weir come to see mother Weir Dec 31.
- Feb 6 - Sand + snow blizzard. Worst I ever saw.
- March 22 - Last day of our school this time.
- April 1 - I set out 40 peach trees.
- April 3 - I got one bu. taters of H. McMillen \$1.00.
- April 6 - I got 5 from Frank White from Dayton  
and I paid Sam Stegall \$1.75 for corn. I had got.
- April 7 - I sold to Parthenment 10 pigs for \$30.
- April 20 - I set out some apple trees.



April 25 - Mother and I went to cemetery set out some  
rose bushes.

May 14, 17, + 18 - I hauled 40 loads manure to orchard.

May 27-28 - Two of the worst days I ever saw in May  
very strong hot winds Blowed about 60 hours steady  
Burnt late tops a little every body discouraged &  
some leaving. Pastures about gone and meadows look  
like December.

May 30 Dry spell broke with good rain in decoration day

July 26, 27, + 28 Hot winds finished the corn crop  
Oct 28 wheat most all come up but grasses began very  
bad on it.

Dec 16 Mamma Haley had young son it died some  
day we buried Mamma's babe in our lot in  
cemetery.

Dec 24 - Frank Strippel - family came to see us  
we all went to Christmas tree at Kellum's school  
house.

Dec 27 - I helped Kellum haul out trees

Dec 28 - I helped Jim Haley husk corn

Jan 12 - Mother Laura - George + Hat went to  
meeting at Juggers.

Jan 18 96 Laura B whole joined M. E. Church

Jan M C White joined M E Church

Jan J H White joined M E Church

Jan Mamma Haley connected at M E Meeting

March 17 Rev A. E. Smith to see us. got me to get  
up a petition for his return to the circuit.

April 1 - I went to Valley + got 1.2 Bury out of Jim's  
we paid back when I had some.



May 12 - we went to town round & hauled some.

we got Ore suit \$3.50 & pair of Lamberton \$2.50

May 18 - I run the weed, licker and then it rain

July 26 - I and J Cooper & Ed Colton started to Junction City to Congressional Convention, we nominated W. D. Vincent on 11th ballot.

Oct 26 we had our 6th Bryan Club meeting & had a speech or 2 each time & music.

Nov 3 Peoples party elected all state officers.

Dec 25 we had a dinner all our children except Harry & Mr Isaac Haley was here.

June 25 1897 had very hard rain last night and wind storm killed woman & 2 children in Bennington township.

Aug 24 Bought me suit - a blue <sup>\$2.00</sup> dress suit \$3.50

Sept 18 I was nominated on second ballot for Bennington by Peoples Party 68 votes cast. I got 32 first ballot & 43 second ballot. A. E. Robinson, Herman Stetter, W. H. Chappell & Harris was candidates for nomination.

Sept 25 Had a surprise on mother, she got a new carpet for a present. about 30 people here.

Sept 24 I rec'd notice of Henry Pills death.

Oct 20 James Graham & wife Myra Mc Kinney & see us Myra Mc Kinney reunited me with Kippump gem.

Sept 3 Mother died & buried at Ohio

Nov 21 Big snow blizzard. never drifted so much.

Dec 25 we was all at home & worked all day.
