- **Program capacity is 70 people.** Register early to save your spot.
- Non-registered participants may be turned away due to the program capacity limit.

- ♦ Howling will be cancelled due to lightning, heavy wind or rain. The decision to cancel will be made no later than 1 ½ hours before the howling start time. A message will be left on the Coalition's answering service announcing the cancellation. The phone number is 252-796-5600.
- **Personal vehicles will be used to caravan back to howling site. Refuge roads are mostly gravel.**
- **❖** Bring a flashlight and insect repellant. (Temperature and insect extremes are common.)

Directions to Howling Site

- * Meet at Alligator River National Wildlife Refuge entrance, at Creef Cut Wildlife Trail, at the intersection of Milltail Road and US Hwy 64.
- *FROM POINTS WEST: Approximately 7 miles from the bridge over Alligator River, on Hwy 64 East, the refuge entrance is on the right. A sign for Milltail Road will be on the left and a Creef Cut Trail sign is on right.
- *FROM POINTS EAST: Approximately 5 miles over the Virginia Dare Bridge, on US Hwy 64 W Bypass, the Refuge entrance is on the left. The sign for Milltail Road is also on your right, before you see the Creef Cut Trial sign on your left.
- *FROM NAGS HEAD & KILL DEVIL HILLS AREA: Take 158 South to the Hwy 64 W Bypass. Cross the Virginia Dare bridge and continue traveling east through Manns Harbor. Creef Cut is approximately 5 miles over the bridge on the left, on Hwy 64 W.
