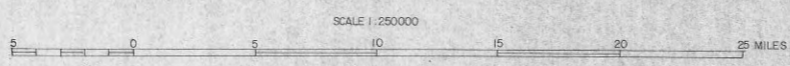


**548 Sample site location / number**
