CGRP funding was used to thin around 5,000 acres of pinon-juniper and 4,000 acres of ponderosa pine. Thinning totals by forest type are described in the SWEIS Affected Environment piece that I wrote for you last year. We have since thinned another 150+ acres of p-j in TAs 54 and 36.
