**Subject: SWEIS BASELINE AND ALTERNATIVES EMISSION RATE CALCULATIONS FOR TA-50**


Dear Mohammed:

LANL staff at ESH-17 have reviewed past emissions from TA-50 and have determined that these emissions are insignificant relative to other sources at the Laboratory. Staff members have also reviewed proposed operation of the TA-50 facility under all of the alternatives identified in the memo "Data Projections for the Waste Management Facility" (ESH-EIS:97-056). Our conclusion is that, regardless of the alternative, emissions from TA-50 will continue to be insignificant compared to other sources at the Laboratory.


