Your participation in the analysis for these projects can promote better decisions by informing us of your concerns regarding the potential impacts of our proposed projects and by reviewing our analysis and alternatives. - 3) allow you to determine which projects to get involved with.

ROD (Record of Decision)

This type of decision document i used when an Environmental Im Statement (EIS) has been produ Decisions documented in a Recc Of Decision are ubject to administrative appeals.

EIS (Environmental Impact Statement)

This document discloses the environmental impacts to be expected from the proposed acti and from specific alternatives to proposed action. An EIS is prepa when significant environmental impacts are anticipated. Your comments are requested within days of release of a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS). Your comments are considered prior to making the findecision and are responded to ir Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS).

DN (Decision Notice)

This type of decision document i used when an Environmental Assessment (EA) is conducted a it is concluded that no significant environmental impact will result i implementing the preferred alternative. (If a significant environmental impact will result, EIS must be prepared.) Decision documented in a Decision Notice are subject to administrative app unless there has been no expression of public interest in thaction.

EA (Environmental Assessment)

This document discloses the environmental impacts to be expected from the proposed acti and from specific alternatives to proposed action. An EA is prepa when significant environmental impacts are not anticipated or will there is a question as to the exte of the impacts. Your comments a requested within 30 days of relea of an EA. Your comments are considered prior to making the fill decision and are responded to in appendix to the EA.

DM (Decision Memo)

A number of categories of action have been determined from prior experience and analysis to result

no significant impact to the environment. If a proposed actio falls into one of these categories and if no extraordinary circumstances exist which might cause an adverse impact in the specific case, these actions can "categorically excluded" from documentation in an EA or EIS. Decision Memo document is use when the environmental analysis has been "categorically excluded Ordinarily, decisions documente a Decision Memo are not subjec administrative appeal; the excep is the category of small timber sa (unless there has been no expression of public interest in the sale).
