Data usually printed in this table can be found in the *National Survey of Fishing, Hunting, and Wildlife-Associated Recreation*, published by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Department of the Interior. Traditionally, the Bureau of Land Management has extracted data from this publication and increased the economic values by an annual growth rate calculated from the Consumer Price Index.

The Bureau is currently entering into a contract with the U.S. Forest Service and other private parties to conduct a more specialized survey that will enhance data accuracy for BLM public lands.
