## Wheeler National Wildlife Refuge 2005-2006 Hunt Summaries

Approximately 9,500 permits were provided to prospective hunters during the 2005-2006 season. Public hunting on the Refuge was allowed on approximately 18,000 acres. Areas were open for hunting daily during the seasons excluding Sundays when all hunting was prohibited. Some areas had restrictions on species legal for harvest, methods of entry, and dates of entry. The Refuge administered all hunts with the exception of 4,000 acres of Refuge lands located within the Redstone Arsenal. Hunting in this area was administered by personnel with the Redstone Arsenal Recreation Center.

Species legal for harvest and open seasons were as follows:

## **SMALL GAME**

Estimates for small game harvests for the 2005-2006 season are as follows: 925-1,400 gray squirrels; 35-50 fox squirrels; 350-525 eastern cottontail rabbits; 70-100 swamp rabbits; 225-350 raccoons; 1-5 opossums; 45-70 quail.

## **BIG GAME**

A total of 80 deer and four (4) feral hogs were reported as being harvested on refuge lands, excluding lands within Redstone Arsenal. Hunters were required to report harvested deer and feral hogs within 72 hours. No hunter check stations were staffed. The breakdown of reports is as follows:
