








(9) Public and private organizations should take steps to improve the public's understanding of cancer prevention and early detection with a focus on promoting healthy lifestyles and informed decisionmaking about health behaviors and cancer screening. Raising public awareness of the benefits of cancer prevention and early detection is central to reducing the cancer burden. One barrier to effective communication is the contradictory and sometimes questionable research reported by the news media. Expanded health communications research, particularly via the Health Communications and Informatics Branch at NCI, is needed to improve understanding of which communications approaches - both individual (e.g., patientprovider) and communitybased (e.g., news media) - are most effective with specific populations to prevent and


control cancer.






