BRIEF DESCRIPTION: Apollo 13: Reentry Success, a project which is sustainable and replicable and has measurable outcomes, addresses one of the most significant factors in recidivism, unemployment, by linking former inmates to comprehensive, employment services at the moment they walk out of prison or jail gates. Clients will be referred to Apollo 13, where they will work with case managers from the one-stop system to have their skills and interests assessed and to develop Individual Employment Plans. The community and faith-based organizations will enhance their capacity to serve these and other clients and, by working under performance-based contracts, will hone their ability to produce results. The goal is to ease transition by reconnecting these individuals with family, community, and jobs.
