

**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

On January 9, 2002, Respondent Schering-Plough Corporation ("Schering") filed an unopposed motion for an extension of time for filing its response to Complaint Counsel's Motion *In Limine* to Limit or Exclude Duplicative and Improper Testimony. The Scheduling Order requires responses to motions *in limine* to be filed on January 10, 2002. Schering seeks an extension of time for filing its response by 2:00 p.m. on January 14, 2002. Complaint Counsel previously sought and was granted a similar extension of time for filing its responses to Respondents' motions *in limine* by order dated January 8, 2002.

On January 9, 2002, all parties were informed by telephone that Schering's unopposed motion for an extension of time was granted. Accordingly, Schering's motion is GRANTED. Schering's response to Complaint Counsel's motion *in limine* is due by 2:00 p.m. on January 14, 2002.
