The Commission has been conducting an investigation to determine whether the acquisition by Scientific Games Corp. of Oberthur Gaming Technologies Corp. violated Section 7 of the Clayton Act or Section 5 of the Federal Trade Commission Act.

Upon further review of this matter, it now appears that no further action is warranted by the Commission at this time. Accordingly, pursuant to authority delegated by the Commission, 49 Fed. Reg. 6171, the investigation has been closed.
