Dear Mr. Taffet:

The Federal Trade Commission's Bureau of Competition has conducted a nonpublic investigation to determine whether Forgent Networks, Inc. ("Forgent") had engaged or was engaging in unfair methods of competition in or affecting commerce in violation of Section 5 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, 15 U.S.C. § 45, as amended, by subverting or otherwise undermining the JPEG standard-setting processes of the International Organization for Standardization ("ISO"), International Electrotechnical Commission ("IEC"), Comite Consultatif International Telephonique et Telegraphic ("CCITT"), Joint Technical Committee, American National Standards Institute ("ANSI"), any of their committees, working groups or experts groups, or of their predecessors, successors, parents, affiliates or other standard-setting bodies.

Upon reviewing this matter, it now appears that no additional action is warranted by the Commission at this time. Accordingly, pursuant to the authority delegated by the Commission, 49 Fed. Reg. 6147 (1984), the investigation has been closed. This action is not to be construed as a determination that a violation may not have occurred, just as the pendency of an investigation should not be construed as a determination that a violation has occurred. The Commission reserves the right to take such further action as the public interest may require.
