


STANDING ORDER GOVERNING
MANDATORY ELECTRONIC CASE FILING

By unanimous consensus of the Court, effective **January 1, 2006** all cases, proceedings, motions, memorandum of law and other pleadings or documents filed with the court must be filed using the Electronic Case Filing System, unless otherwise exempt pursuant to the Administrative Procedures For Electronic Case Filing.


Effective immediately, the Clerk of Court is hereby directed to provide notice of mandatory electronic case filing to counsel of record in civil and criminal cases.

Such notice shall be posted on the Court's internet web site and also disseminated through manual or electronic means.
