# MOTION UNDER 28 USC § 2255 TO VACATE, SET ASIDE, OR CORRECT SENTENCE By Person in Federal Custody

Note: If you are attacking a judgment which imposed a sentence to be served in the future, you must fill in the name of the federal court in which the judgment was imposed.

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. All motions must be submitted on the Northern District of Mississippi's Form P2, pursuant to the court's *Standing Order* dated July 1, 1998. Motions must be typewritten or legibly handwritten, and signed by you under penalty of perjury. Any false statement of a material fact may serve as the basis for prosecution and conviction for perjury. All questions must be answered concisely in the proper space on Form P2.
- 2. Use the spaces provided in Form P2 to present your case. Do not use additional pages except with respect to the facts upon which you rely to support your case. Citation of cases, statutes, or other authority is not required. Briefs and argument are not required; however, if they are provided, they must be submitted in the form of a separate memorandum.
- 3. A motion may challenge the judgment entered by one judge *only*. If you seek to challenge judgments entered by two or more judges in the Northern District of Mississippi, you must file a separate motion for each.
- 4. Include in your motion *all* grounds and bases for relief, together will all supporting facts. All grounds and bases for relief, and all supporting facts, not included in your motion will be considered as legally waived.
