ORDER ON MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

The Court has before it the Trustee's Motion for Summary Judgment Re: Count II (City of Manchester, New Hampshire) ("motion"). In his motion, the Trustee requests that summary judgment be granted with respect to his claim against Defendant City of Manchester, New Hampshire. The Trustee filed his motion on April 26, 1999, and the City of Manchester has not responded. Attached to the Trustee's motion is a letter from Attorney Thomas I. Arnold, III, stating that the City of Manchester will not appear in the above-captioned adversary proceeding because its real estate taxes and water and sewer charges have been paid in full.
