As an owner of a commercial flooring company, I want to express my feelings on the use of Sorona by Mohawk in the residential market. I have witnessed the performance qualities over a period of time and am impressed with the styling, durability, and extreme resistance to staining. It is a high quality fiber that I would like to see introduced into the commercial market when they are able to provide appropriate warranties for that application. That being said, this is a quality fiber in and of itself. It would be a terrible disservice to our industry to label this as a polyester fiber. The characteristics are not consistent with the poor long term performance we witnessed in carpet made from polyester fiber, such as pilling, crushing, and difficulty to dye. This is a fiber that must have its own identity to parallel with its outstanding performance.
