RE: Prerecorded Call Prohibition EBR Telemarketing, Project No. R411001

I would like the commission to realize that I appreciate receiving prerecorded phone messages from those I do business with. These sales calls allow me to save time and money and I find no reason for the government to interfere with my relationship with those that I choose to do business with.

I am opposed to the FTC's proposal that would require written authorization to receive pre-recorded telemarketing calls from the businesses that I have an Established Business Relationship with. I am aware of the burden this would place on these businesses and I find it ridiculous that you place such a Burdon on these businesses.

I would ask the Commission to either adopt the EBR exception contained in the TCPA that creates an exception for pre-recorded calls sent by companies that have an EBR with the person they are calling or continue its forbearance towards businesses that send pre-recorded messages to those with an EBR beyond January 2, 2007.
