RE: Prerecorded Call Prohibition EBR Telemarketing, Project No. R411001

My child's day care facility sends pre-recorded sales messages to facilitate "Picture Day" I like the fact that they call me and ask me to press a number on my phone that allows me to make my pre-purchase of my Childs photos, set up picture time and date. This is one example of many that I would present to you as a reason not to support your proposal.

I am opposed to the FTC's proposal that would require written authorization to receive pre-recorded telemarketing calls from the businesses and charities that I have an Established Business Relationship with. I am aware of the burden this would place on these businesses.

I would ask the Commission to either adopt the EBR exception contained in the TCPA that creates an exception for pre-recorded calls sent by companies that have an EBR with the person they are calling or continue its forbearance towards businesses that send pre-recorded messages to those with an EBR beyond January 2, 2007.
