I am a boat owner and the facility that I store my boat each winter contacts all of its customers including me using a pre-recorded sales message allowing me to instantly reserve my spot for winter storage. I have asked the marina that I dock my boat in to do the same. This is a very convenient way for me to do business with these vendors. Please respect my ability to receive live prerecorded sales calls.

I am opposed to the FTC's proposal that would require written authorization to receive prerecorded telemarketing calls from the businesses and charities that I have an Established Business Relationship with. I am aware of the burden this would place on these businesses.

I would ask the Commission to either adopt the EBR exception contained in the TCPA that creates an exception for pre-recorded calls sent by companies that have an EBR with the person they are calling or continue its forbearance towards businesses that send pre-recorded messages to those with an EBR beyond January 2, 2007.
