SUBJECT: ANNUAL ASSESSMENT LETTER - GRAND GULF NUCLEAR STATION
(NRC INSPECTION REPORT 05000416/2008001)

Dear Mr. Brian:

On February 7, 2008, the NRC staff completed its performance review of the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station for the calendar year 2007 assessment cycle. Our technical staff reviewed performance indicators for the most recent quarter and inspection results for the period from January 1 through December 31 2007. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of our assessment of your safety performance during this period and our plans for future inspections at your facility.

This performance review and enclosed inspection plan do not include security information. A separate letter designated and marked as "Official Use Only--Security Information" will include the security cornerstone review and resultant inspection plan.

Overall, Grand Gulf Nuclear Station operated in a manner that preserved public health and safety and fully met all cornerstone objectives. Plant performance for the most recent quarter at Grand Gulf Nuclear Station was within the Licensee Response Column of the NRC's Action Matrix, based on all inspection findings being classified as having very low safety significance (Green) and all performance indicators indicating performance at a level requiring no additional NRC oversight (Green). Therefore, we plan to conduct reactor oversight process baseline inspections at your facility.

During this assessment period the NRC staff identified a crosscutting theme in the human performance component of decision making involving the aspect of using conservative input assumptions. Eight findings were related to this theme, affecting the Mitigating Systems, Initiating Events, and Occupational Radiation Safety Cornerstones. Examples include; inadequate operability assessments for a degraded switchgear ventilation system, diesel generator jacket water control valve, and residual heat removal heat exchanger; the failure to establish an appropriate frequency for evaluating the radiological hazards associated with a reactor coolant leak; the failure to establish appropriate limitations for performing troubleshooting activities that resulted in an unplanned power reduction. To address problems in this area, your staff developed an improvement plan in 2007; however, it is not clear that the scope of efforts to address the negative trend in decision making has been effective. As a result, a substantive crosscutting issue in Human Performance was identified. This substantive crosscutting issue will remain open until we determine, through implementation of focused baseline inspections, that future corrective actions have resulted in sustained improved performance.


Additionally, in the human performance component of work practices a crosscutting theme in the aspect of human error prevention techniques was identified. Five findings were related to this theme, affecting the Mitigating Systems, Initiating Events, and Occupational Radiation Safety Cornerstones. We determined that your staff appropriately recognized the declining trend, evaluated the declining trend in your corrective action program, and implemented effective corrective actions. Based on this, we have concluded that the scope of your efforts to address this crosscutting theme appears appropriate and we will continue to monitor the effectiveness of your actions through baseline inspection activities.

The enclosed inspection plan details the inspections, except those related to physical protection scheduled through June 30, 2009. The inspection plan is provided to allow for the resolution of any scheduling conflicts and personnel availability issues well in advance of inspector arrival onsite. Routine resident inspections are not listed due to their ongoing and continuous nature. The inspections in the last nine months of the inspection plan are tentative and may be revised at the midcycle review.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html> (the Public Electronic Reading Room).

The NRC is currently evaluating the scope and frequency of all baseline inspection procedures. If the results of the evaluation, or any other circumstances, cause us to change the inspection plan, we will contact you to discuss the change as soon as possible.
