This responds to your letter of August 23, 2005, concerning the Buy American Report that agencies are required to submit under Section 645 of Division F of the fiscal year 2004 Consolidated Appropriations Act (Public Law 108-199). - 1) The Agency has not purchased articles, materials, or supplies that were manufactured outside the United States in Fiscal Years 2004 or 2005.
- 2) No waivers were requested or granted under the Buy American Act.
- 3) The total procurement funds spent by the Agency on goods manufactured in the Unites States during Fiscal Year 2004 was \$10,564,189; in 2005, that total was \$4,343,810.
