

General Guidelines for Obligations on Imports from the DOE NNSA Office of Nonproliferation Policy

Any material coming from an EU country directly or indirectly will be subject to the US/EURATOM agreement. You can rest assured that EURATOM will make the necessary notifications.

Any material coming from Canada directly or indirectly will be subject to the US/Canada agreement only if it is of Canadian origin, not just converted in Canada. If it is of Canadian origin, you can rest assured that Canada will make the necessary notifications.

Any material coming from Australia directly or indirectly will be subject to the US/Australia agreement. You can rest assured that Australia will make the necessary notifications.

Any material coming from China directly or indirectly will be subject to the US/China agreement only if China requests that it be in advance. The vast majority of Chinese origin or processed material that has come to, or passed through, the U.S. has thus far been unobligated. More and more China is requesting that material be subject to the Agreement.

NMMSS Report M-742-EX, A Useful Tool in Reconciling Facility Books with NMMSS

NMMSS report M-742-EX, Material Transaction Report Transaction Detail, is a NMMSS generated material balance report that shows detailed transaction data from which summary data lines on the generated M-742 are created. Facilities that desire to reconcile their internal MBR to the NMMSS generated M-742 can use the M-742-EX as a tool to identify any transaction differences between the NMMSS and their own facility records. Use of this report is encouraged as a way to efficiently identify differences for resolution.

Licensee Training in NMMSS Reporting

The training course for licensee personnel was postponed from this past winter until this fall. We believe this schedule will be better suited to NMMSS users. The course will last three days and will include the following topics, among others:

- Completion of data input forms: transaction, material balance and inventory



- Demonstration of use of SAMS in creating electronic data submissions
- Options for sending data to NMMSS electronically
- Review of the 2003 NUREG reporting changes

The course will be held in Atlanta on October 18-20, 2004. The desired class size is 20 or less.
