Additional Protocol Treaty Rule issued by the NRC

On December 23, 2008, the Federal Register published the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's direct final rule to implement the Additional Protocol Treaty. This NRC rule became effective December 23, 2008, and has requirements [e.g. 10 CFR 75.11(c) and 110.54(a)] for licensees to report certain information within thirty days. The rule does not impact reporting of data to NMMSS and the following is provided as information only.

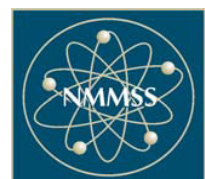
