## Additional Protocol

As part of the pre-Users meeting to the 2008 NMMSS Users Annual Training Meeting, Tom Grice of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission made a presentation on the "Additional Protocol" treaty and its likely impact on industry.

The Department of Commerce and Nuclear Regulatory Commission are very close to publishing final regulations to implement the "Additional Protocol" treaty.
