The purpose of this memorandum is to inform you that the reaffirmation notification process for the subject standard has been completed in accordance with the technical standards program procedures. This included a 90-day review (60 days are required) by the Department of Energy (DOE) technical standards managers (TSM). TSM alternates topical committee chairpersons and representatives of the DOE fire safety committee. All comments were satisfactorily resolved in favor of the proposal.

Based on the responses received, we recommend that the standard be reaffirmed and request that you transmit the appropriate direction for publication/distribution to the Performance Assurance Project Office in Oak Ridge, Tennessee.
