

Indonesia

Update on Progress

- ★ On December 11, 2008, Indonesia was selected as eligible for a Millennium Challenge Corporation poverty reduction grant, or compact, by MCC's Board of Directors.
- ★ On December 19, 2008, MCC Compact Development experts met with representatives from the Embassy of Indonesia, including Indonesia's envoy to the United States, Ambassador Sudjadnan, to discuss the compact development process.
- ★ An initial MCC high-level visit to Indonesia to meet with a variety of stakeholders, including representatives of the Indonesian government, members of the private sector, other donor organizations, and NGOs, took place April 2009. The objectives of the initial trip were to build working relationships with key contacts, explain the MCC model and process of compact development to stakeholders, and to set expectations as to the timeline for development of a potential compact.
- ★ Indonesia continues to implement a two-year, \$55 million MCC Threshold Program focused on reducing corruption in the judiciary, providing support for the Anti-Corruption Commission, enhancing the performance of the Financial Transaction Reports and Analysis Center and developing pilot e-procurement systems in five provinces. The program is also helping Indonesia build a robust and sustainable immunization system in difficult to reach areas.
