## **N.L.R.B. ELECTION REPORT**

### **CASES CLOSED NOVEMBER 2001**

NOTE: This monthly report lists the outcome of secret-ballot voting by employees in NLRB-conducted representation elections as officially certified following resolution of postelection objections and/or challenges. During FY 2002, the NLRB continued to improve its techniques for tracking and collecting case activity data.
