Lines 4 and 5 - Switched access - Include calling service provided through the local exchange carriers' wirecenter.

Lines 4 and 5 - Special access - Include calling services provided by connecting a customer location to a serving carrier by means of a dedicated private line, thus bypassing the local wirecenter.

Lines 4, 5, and 7 - Intrastate - Include services that state governments regulate either explicitly or implicitly.

Lines 4, 5, and 7 - Interstate - Include services that the federal government (FCC) regulates either explicitly or implicitly.

Lines 4, 5, and 7 - International - Include services that are the result of treaty - either bilateral or through an international agency such as the United Nations (UN).

Line 5 - Inbound - Include calls made from a fixed customer location which are paid for by the recipient of the call.

Lines 6 and 9d - Include the transmission and switching of voice, data, and video over the PSTN where calling charges are not distance sensitive (no distinction between local and long distance areas).

Line 7 - Include wired or wireless (satellite, microwaves, cellular, etc.) telecommunication link(s) between specified points for the exclusive use of the client. Exclude the provision of private links to telecommunication service providers.

Line 9a - Include the provision of access to the public switched telephone network for the transmission and switching of voice, data, and video within a local calling area where the call originates from or terminates into a portable handset. Also include calls using cellular, PCS, ESMR technology, satellite, and other mobile services.

Line 9c - Include the transmission and switching of voice, data, and video over the Public Switched Telephone Network (PSTN) between local calling area where the call is made from or received with a portable handset. Also include roaming services (additional charges to locate mobile equipment that has been transported outside the customer's mobile exchange area) and satellite services.

Line 9e - Include the provision of a mobile radio service that subscribers primarily use to receive voice, text, or tone messages with small radio receivers. These devices may or may not be accessed by the PSTN.
