

Gila River Indian Community Pima-Maricopa Irrigation Project

Project Description

Funding will accelerate construction of the Community's Pima-Maricopa Irrigation Project, part of the Central Arizona Project's distribution system within the Community, which is located southwest of Phoenix. The Pima Lateral Canal is the main water conveyance feature of the water delivery system, which will ultimately deliver water to as many as 146,000 acres of Community lands each year.

Project Benefits

Accelerating the funding for this project will:

- Enable the Community to construct 10.5 miles of new concrete-lined canal.
- Enable the construction of 7 check structures in the Pima Lateral Canal.
- Allow the Community to meet commitments to serve additional irrigated lands with water by the end of fiscal year 2010.
