**CERTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 1201 OF
THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT:**

Pursuant to Title XII, section 1201 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Pub. L. 111-5 (Feb. 17, 2009)) ("ARRA"), I, M. Michael Rounds, Governor of the State of South Dakota, hereby certify to the Secretary of Transportation that the State of South Dakota will maintain its effort with regard to State funding for the types of projects in DOT "covered programs" funded under ARRA. The list below of DOT "covered programs" identifies the amount of funds the State plans to expend from State sources from February 17, 2009, to September 30, 2010, for the types of projects under the DOT "covered programs" funded under ARRA.

I understand that if the State of South Dakota is unable to maintain the level of funding identified in this list of the types of projects under the DOT "covered programs" funded under ARRA, the State of South Dakota will thereafter be prohibited by the Secretary of Transportation from receiving additional limitation on obligations for Federal-aid highway and highway safety construction programs that occurs after August 1 for fiscal year 2011.

"Highway Infrastructure Investment" – Federal Highway Administration – The South Dakota Department of Transportation plans to spend \$76.701 million in state funds for highway and bridge planning and construction projects from February 17, 2009 to September 30, 2010, assuming Congress funds the "covered programs" in FFY 2009 and 2010 at the same levels as in FFY 2008.

"Grants-in-Aid for Airports" – Federal Aviation Administration \$ 1,553,440

"Transit Capital Assistance" – Federal Transit Administration \$1,055,000
