


**CERTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 1201 OF
THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT:**

Pursuant to Title XII, section 1201 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Pub. L. 111-5 (Feb. 17, 2009)) ("ARRA"), I C.L. "Butch" Otter, the Governor of the State of Idaho, hereby certify to the Secretary of the Department of Transportation (DOT) that the State of Idaho will maintain its effort with regard to State funding for the types of projects in the DOT "covered programs" funded under the ARRA. The enclosed list of DOT "covered programs" identifies the amount of funds the State plans to expend from State sources from February 17, 2009 to September 30, 2010 in accordance with the ARRA. Idaho is certifying these planned amounts of state funding for FFY 2009 and FFY 2010 for the required maintenance of effort under the ARRA for covered programs (see attachment).

I understand that if the State of Idaho is unable to maintain the level of funding identified in this list of "covered programs" funded under ARRA, the State of Idaho will thereafter be prohibited by the Secretary of Transportation from receiving additional limitation on obligations for Federal-aid highway and highway safety construction programs that occur after August 1 for federal fiscal year 2011.
