\$38 Million in Federal Stimulus Funds Allocated for Water and Sewer Projects

CHEYENNE, Wyo. – At a special meeting of the State Loan and Investment Board (SLIB) today, the board allocated nearly \$40 million in federal economic stimulus funds to communities across Wyoming.

The federal stimulus bill allocated \$19.2 million for the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) and \$19.5 million for the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF).

The Board approved 43 projects in communities across the state, including water and sewer improvements funded by the two state revolving funds for clean water and drinking water.

Clean Water State Revolving Fund Loans

The 21 projects approved for the Clean Water State Revolving fund represent 14 of Wyoming's 23 counties: Big Horn (1), Campbell (1), Carbon (3), Crook (1), Fremont (1), Laramie (1), Lincoln (2), Natrona (1), Park (3), Sheridan (2), Sublette (1), Teton (2), Washakie (1) and Weston (1).

The Board's allocation includes funding for three (3) Clean Water State Revolving Fund Green Project and eighteen (18) Clean Water State Revolving Fund Conventional Projects.

Counties which no CWSRF applications were received for today's meeting include: Albany, Converse, Goshen, Hot Springs, Johnson, and Platte.

Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Loans (DWSRF)

The 22 projects approved for the Drinking Water State Revolving fund represent 14 of Wyoming's 23 counties: Big Horn (2), Carbon (3), Crook (2), Fremont (1), Laramie (2), Lincoln (4), Natrona (1), Niobrara (1), Park (1), Sheridan (1), Sublette (1), Teton (1), Washakie (1) and Weston (1).

The Board's allocation includes funding for five (5) Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Green Project and sixteen (16) Drinking Water State Revolving Funds Conventional Projects.

Counties which no DWSRF applications were received include: Albany, Campbell, Goshen, Hot Springs, Johnson, Platte and Uinta.

The Board approved 23% set aside for funding of SRF programs for green infrastructure projects. The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) contain specific provisions concerning the funding of green infrastructure. Collectively, green infrastructure includes energy efficiency, water efficiency, green design, and environmentally innovative projects.
