

Privacy Statement

The Capital Development Board (CDB) is committed to protecting your online privacy while providing you with the most useful and enjoyable web experience possible. While you can use many features of our web site anonymously, you may be required to provide personal information to gain access to some of our restricted content and services.

Information collected and received through CDB web sites may become public records and therefore subject to disclosure under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act. It is therefore the policy of CDB that no personal information you provide to us, including your name, address, telephone number, drivers license number, Social Security Number and email address will be sold or rented to any entity or individual. The release of personal information shall be limited to the CDB government agencies and/or to authorized Department contractors or grantees.

Personal Information and Choice

"Personal information" is information about an individual that is readily identifiable to that specific individual. Personal information includes personal identifiers such as an individual's name, address, phone number, driver's license number, and social security number. A domain name or Internet Protocol (IP) address is not considered personal information. We collect no personal information about you unless you voluntarily participate in an activity that asks for information (e.g., sending an e-mail or participating in a survey). If you choose not to participate in these activities, your choice will in no way affect your ability to use any other feature of CDB web sites. If personal information is requested on the web site or volunteered by the user, state law and the federal Privacy Act of 1974 may protect it. However, this information is a public record once you provide it, and may be subject to public inspection and copying if not protected by federal or state law. Users are cautioned that the collection of personal information requested from or volunteered by children on-line or by email will be treated the same as information given by an adult and may be subject to public access.

Policies for Individuals Under 13 Years of Age

CDB is committed to complying fully with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act. Accordingly, if you are under the age of 13, you are not authorized to provide us with personally identifying information, and we will not use any such information in our database or other data collection activities. We appreciate your cooperation with this federally mandated requirement.

Web Logs

CDB analyzes our web site logs to continually improve the value of the materials available on our site. Our web site logs are not personally identifiable, and we make no attempt to link them with the individuals that browse CDB web sites.

Log Information Collected and How It Is Used

If you do nothing during your visit to CDB websites but browse or download information, we automatically collect and store the following information about your visit:

- The IP address and domain name used but not the email address. The IP address is a numerical identifier assigned either to your Internet service provider or directly to your computer. We use the IP address to direct Internet traffic to you.
- 2. The type of browser and operating system you used.

- 3. The date and time you visited this site.
- 4. The web pages or services you accessed at this site.

Correspondence

If during your visit to CDB websites you participate in a survey or send an email, the following additional information will be collected:

- 1. E-mail correspondence: The e-mail address and contents of the e-mail.
- 2. Surveys: Any information you volunteered in response to a survey. The information collected is not limited to text characters and may include audio, video, and graphic information formats that you have provided. We use your email to respond appropriately. This may be to respond to you, to address issues you identify, to further improve our web site, or to forward the email to another agency for appropriate action. Survey information is used for the purpose designated.

Cookies

Cookies are pieces of information that a web site transfers to your computer's hard disk for recordkeeping purposes. Cookies can make a web site more useful by personalizing information for visitors and by storing information about your preferences on a particular site. The use of cookies is an industry standard, and many major web sites use them to provide useful features for their customers.

Currently, CDB utilizes a hosted solution from WebTrends Live to collect web site information. WebTrends Live uses cookies only to increase the accuracy and facilitate gathering the data necessary for their customers' reports. This includes information such as the time and date of the visit, the page viewed, the referrer, transaction information for eCommerce pages, and other non-personal data. The cookies never include personal information such as name, mailing address, phone number, or credit card information. WebTrends has no way of collecting such information and visitors that they track cannot provide them with personal information even if they wanted to. Visitors can also accept or reject cookies. Most browsers are initially set up to accept cookies. If you would prefer, you can set your browser to reject cookies.
