The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has granted \$3,886,920.00 in Airport Improvement Projects in New Hampshire as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. It is anticipated that an additional \$1M will be granted to the Manchester-Boston Regional Airport to purchase and Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF) Equipment.

**Boire Field (Nashua)- Airport Terminal Apron Rehabilitation

**Laconia Municipal Airport (Gilford) - Airport Terminal Apron
Rehabilitation
Total project Cost \$835,420.00**
