Electronic Transcripts Are Secure, Fast & Free!

Obtaining and verifying your GED status has never been easier, faster, and more secure. E-Transcripts offer GED examinees complete control over their personal records by providing direct access through the internet. It takes just a few minutes to download and print a transcript for schools, employers, the military, etc. E-Transcripts are free of charge to examinees, so you can print as many copies as you want whenever you need them.

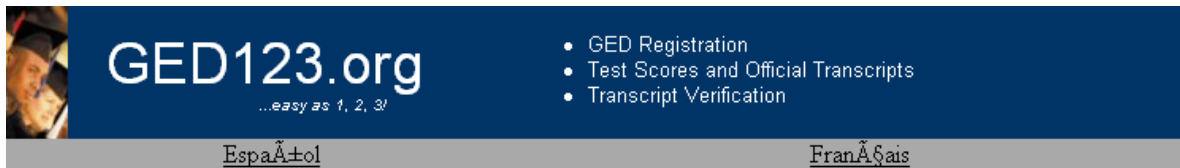
E-Transcripts are also easy for the person receiving it. In a few steps, the receiver can verify the authenticity of the transcript online, using a verification code printed on the E-Transcript. If the transcript matches the on-screen information, verification is complete. It's that simple.

► Employers, School Officials, and Other Verifiers

1. Go to <http://ged123.org>
2. Go to the "Employers, School Officials, and Others" box
3. Type in the Verification Code found in the upper right corner of the Transcript
4. Compare the name and scores with those on the Transcript
5. The Transcript is valid if the name matches and the scores on the Transcript are the same *or lower* than those shown.

2. Go to the "Returning Student" box
Type in your "Access Code" and click "Go"
3. Click on the "My Transcript" tab
4. Choose the preferred language and follow the "Print" or "Save" directions.
