## **Overview of Budget Tables**

- There are 12 tables in the budget section, as seen here. All budget data is in U.S. thousands of dollars (\$000)
- If you need to add a Strategic Objective prior to entering budget data, do so in the Narrative SO Profile Table.
- Initial budget data (FY 2005 FY 2007) will be due by December 16, 2005.
- Once the control numbers for FYs 2006 and 2007 have been determined, your bureau will provide these levels to you and the budget data can be revised and retransmitted if necessary.
