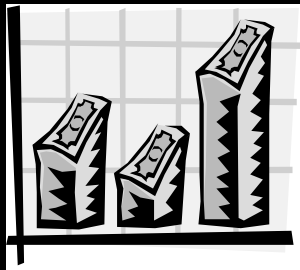

# Cost Savings From Independent Living Services

# Independent Living Cost Savings Background

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A Center for Independent Living (CIL) provides a number of services to people with disabilities. CILs must provide four core services as part of their eligibility requirements to be considered for federal funding through the Rehabilitation Services Administration. Those basic four core services are: Advocacy, Information & Referral, Peer Counseling, and Skills Training.

One of the exciting outcomes of the provision of Independent Living services is the reduction of tax dollars needed by individuals with disabilities who utilize these services to become more self-reliant. Data has recently been collected from Oregon Independent Living Centers to demonstrate some of the savings that have come from the services they have provided. This data does not attempt to collect information about every individual served, but presents some of the data on approximately 10% of the number of clients who had open Consumer Service Records (CSR's), as reported last year to the Rehabilitation Services Administration.

**With nine of the ten Centers reporting, the savings from the attached data alone totals \$3,733,683.22!** This represents an average savings of **\$5,266.13 per individual** served. Since some data is very difficult to collect, some of the estimates do not include savings in food stamps, OHP, TANF, Section 8 or other assistance programs that were no longer needed by some of the consumers represented in the data.
