Public information meeting to discuss proposed improvements for ND Highway 11 scheduled for August 11 in Lidgerwood

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) will hold a public information meeting from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on August 11, at the Lidgerwood Senior Citizens Center. The meeting will utilize an open house format.

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss proposed improvements for N.D. Highway 11 in Lidgerwood from 2nd Street North to the south city limits. The project consists of milling and hot bituminous overlay, surface drainage improvements, sidewalk repairs, new crosswalks, and curb ramp updates.

The public information meeting will provide opportunity for the public to ask questions. Representatives from the NDDOT and the city of Lidgerwood will be on hand to answer your questions and discuss your concerns.
