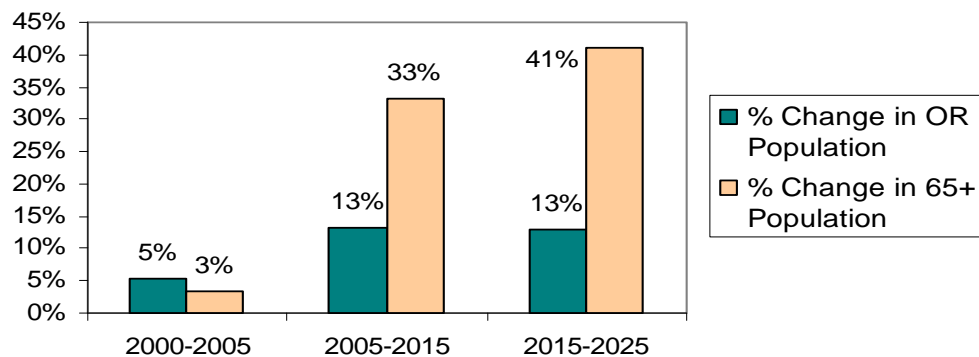

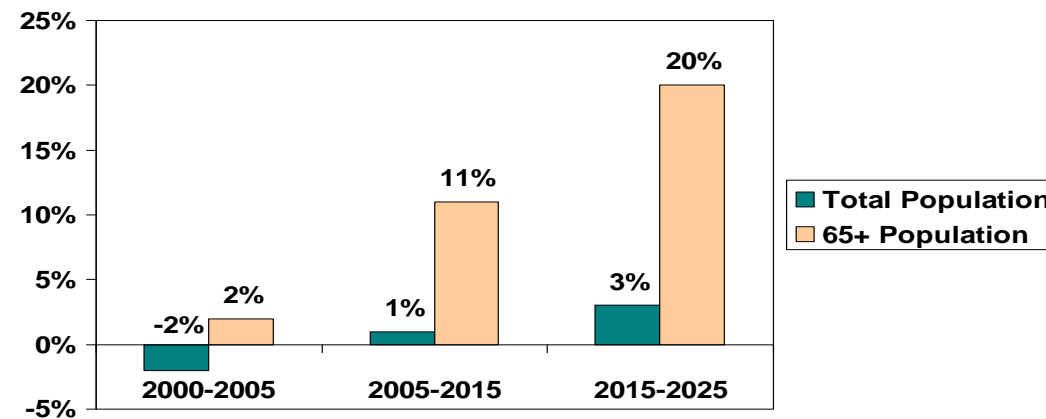

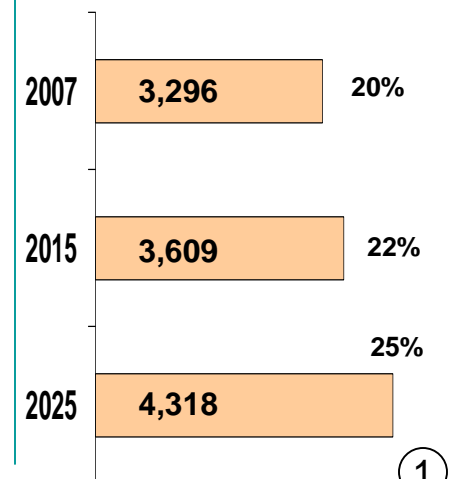

Baker County Projected 65+ Population and % of general population



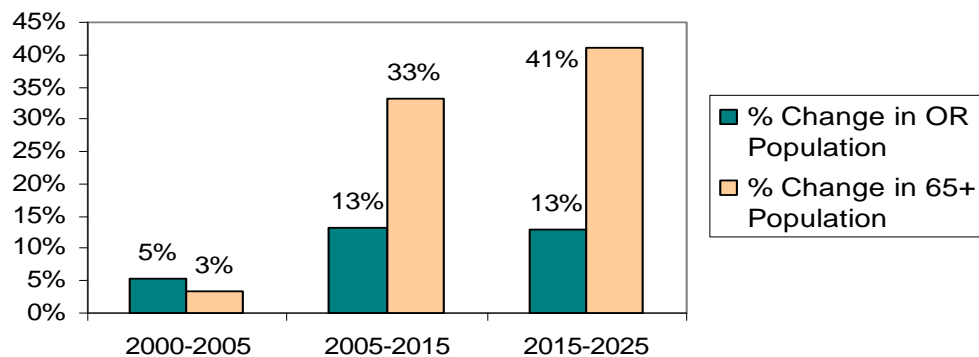

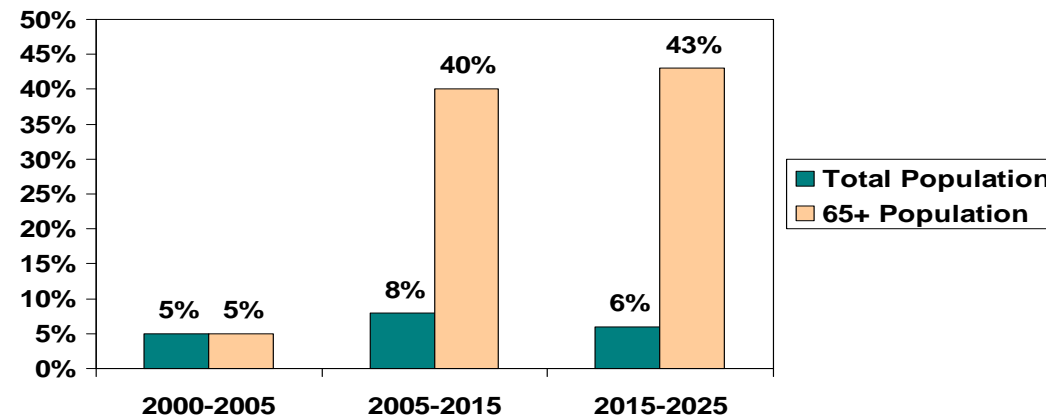

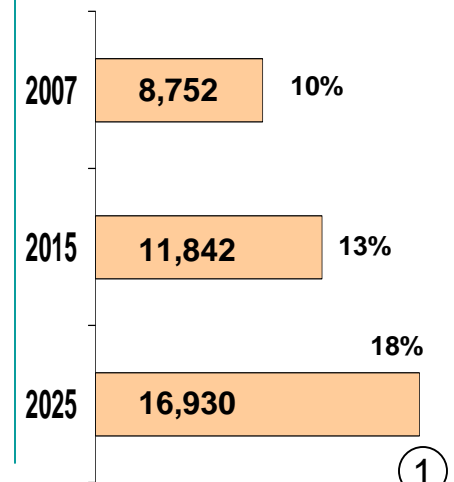
Growth Rate of Oregon's Aging Population

Benton County Projected 65+ Population and % of general population



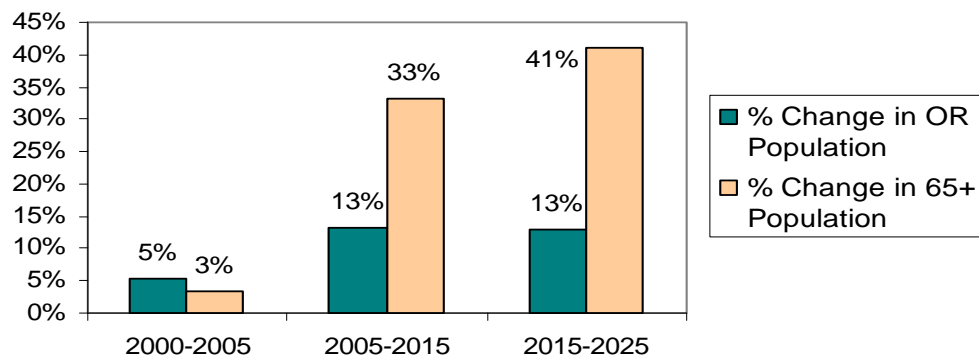

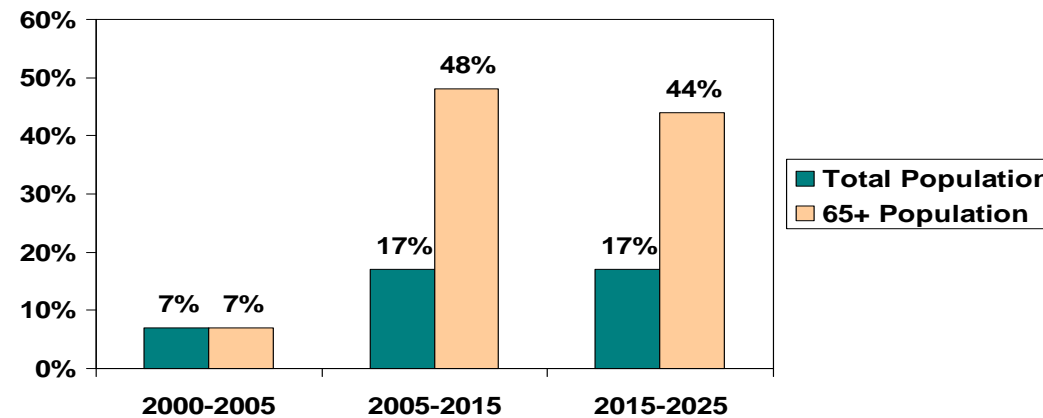

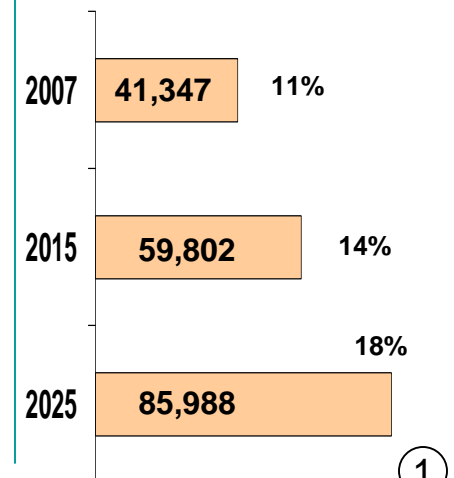

Clackamas County Projected 65+ Population and % of general population



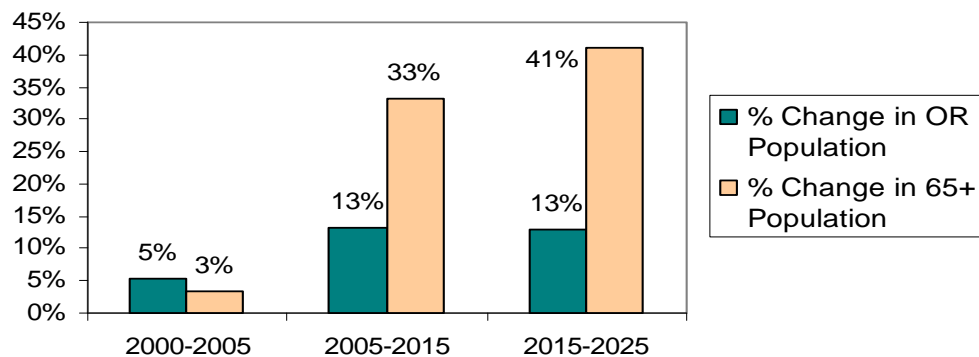

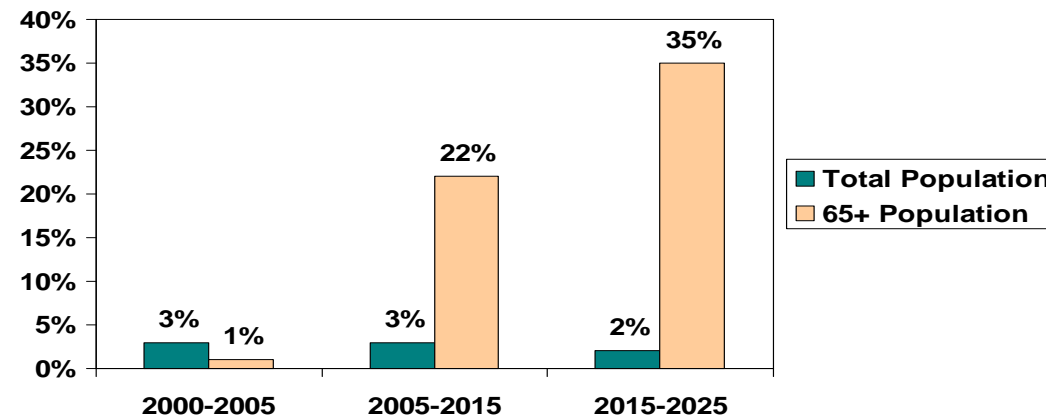

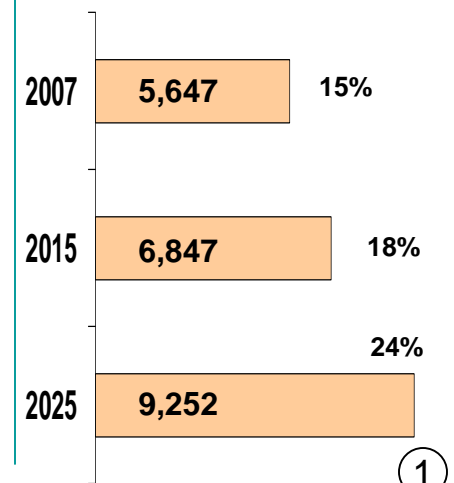

Clatsop County Projected 65+ Population and % of general population

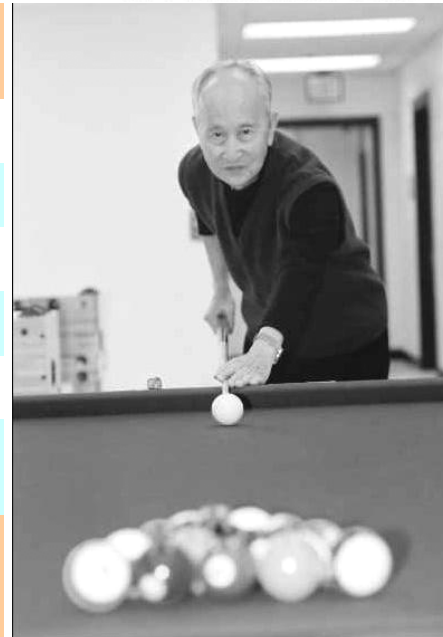

Crook County Projected 65+ Population and % of general population



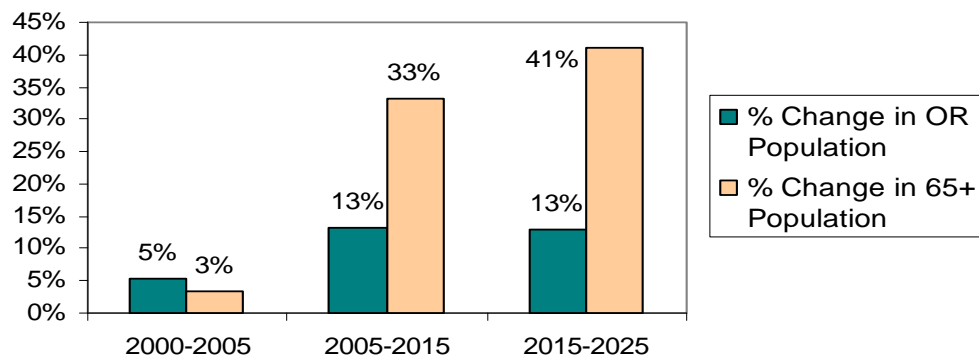

Growth Rate Of Grant County's Aging Population



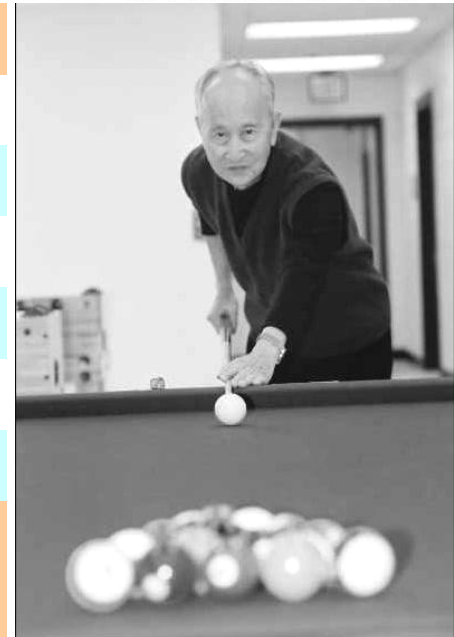
