Adjusted Gross Revenue (AGR)

and AGR-Lite are whole

farm revenue protection

insurance plans.

They provide protection against loss of revenue due to unavoidable natural disasters and market fluctuations.

AGR and AGR-Lite benefits

- Revenue guarantee is based on a five-year average allowable farm income.
- Provides protection for multiple commodities (including livestock) under one policy.
- Protects organic and direct marketing production.
- Improves access to credit.
- Federal government subsidizes up to 59 percent of premium.
- AGR and AGR-Lite policies may meet new requirements for federal disaster assistance programs. Check with your local FSA Service Agency office.

Available coverage in Oregon

- AGR provides up to \$6.5 million in total coverage or asset protection. AGR is available in Benton, Clackamas, Columbia, Lane, Linn, Malheur, Marion, Multnomah, Polk, Washington, and Yamhill counties.
- AGR-Lite provides up to \$1 million in total coverage or asset protection. AGR-Lite is available in all Oregon counties.
- Check with RMA for other coverage areas.

Coverage levels

- 65 percent coverage level with
 75 percent or 90 percent payment rate
- 75 percent coverage level with75 percent or 90 percent payment rate
- 80 percent¹ coverage level with 75 percent or 90 percent payment rate.

March 15

Sales closing date for new AGR-Lite policies.

Year of insurance

You are covered 10 days after the company receives your application for the duration of

- a calendar year (if you are a calendar year tax-filer) or
- a fiscal year (if you file your taxes on a fiscal year basis).

Claims are settled after your taxes are filed for the insurance year.

To qualify for the 80 percent coverage level, you must produce a minimum of three qualifying commodities.
