#### **Return of Equipment and Accessories**

One recorded book or one recorded magazine must be borrowed or downloaded annually from NLS to retain use of equipment and accessories.

## **Certification of Eligibility**

Please have a doctor of medicine, doctor of osteopathy, ophthalmologist, optometrist, librarian, nurse, therapist, or other professional staff of a hospital, institution, or social welfare agency certify your eligibility in the space provided below. Qualified library users must be residents of the United States or United States citizens living abroad.

\_\_\_\_1. **Legally Blind**—persons whose visual acuity, as determined by competent authority, is 20/200 or less in the better eye with correcting glasses, or whose widest diameter of visual field subtends an angular distance no greater than 20 degrees.

\_\_\_\_2. **Visually Disabled**—persons who need aids other than regular glasses for reading standard printed materials.

\_\_\_\_3. **Physically Disabled**—persons unable to read or unable to use standard printed material as a result of physical limitations.

\_\_\_\_4. Deaf-Blindness

# Please Note: in <u>category 5 only - Reading Disabled -</u> eligibility must be certified by a doctor of medicine (MD) or osteopathy (DO).
