Oregon OSHA to partner with Oregon Restaurant Association

Alliance will promote safety and health awareness

(Salem) — As part of an effort to prevent accidents and injuries in the restaurant industry, Oregon's Occupational Safety and Health Division (Oregon OSHA) announces an alliance with the Oregon Restaurant Association.

"The Oregon Restaurant Association is pleased to partner with Oregon OSHA to promote safety in the workplace," said Steve McCoid, president and CEO of the Oregon Restaurant Association. "We hope the restaurant industry will take full advantage of the various health and safety educational programs Oregon OSHA offers."

The alliance will help facilitate discussions about safety and health in the workplace. The ORA will work with Oregon OSHA, a division of the Department of Consumer & Business Services, to develop materials for online workshops and safety programs. Also, the ORA will help promote Oregon OSHA's services to its membership, including the confidential consultation program, and Safety and Health Achievement Recognition Program (SHARP). The agreement will have no effect on enforcement.

"It's easy to underestimate the hazards faced by restaurant workers every day," said OSHA Administrator Michael Wood. "Because they are what we might consider 'ordinary,' they are taken for granted unless we make a special effort to focus attention on them. This alliance will help us raise awareness about those hazards and how easily they can be addressed, leading to fewer injuries in restaurant workplaces."
