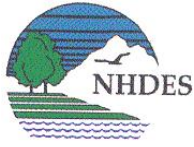

## **New Hampshire Climate Change Action Plan Public Listening Session**

*February 19 from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m.*

Concord, NH - The Governor's Climate Change Policy Task Force will be holding a public listening session on February 19, 2008, from 5:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. in Representatives Hall at the Statehouse in Concord, New Hampshire. The purpose of the listening session is to provide an opportunity for citizens to offer input on the state's Climate Change Action Plan, which is currently being developed and must be submitted to Governor Lynch by September 1, 2008.

This will be the public's first opportunity to contribute to the development of the New Hampshire Climate Change Action Plan. Members of the Climate Change Policy Task Force and staff from the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services will be on hand to provide information on the process and listen to citizen concerns. The event is anticipated to yield valuable insights regarding the potential opportunities and impacts that should be considered early on in the development process.
