Abandoned Vehicles

How do I title a vehicle in my name that has been abandoned?

You must contact ND Highway Patrol and request a VIN Inspection. Submit the completed <u>SFN 2486 Certificate of Vehicle Inspection</u> form and a <u>SFN 51269 a Request</u> for Personal Information form with a \$3.00 fee to the ND Motor Vehicle Records Section.

- If the vehicle has a title record you must contact the last titled owner and request they obtain a duplicate title, and if applicable a lien release, and sign the duplicate title over to you. If you are unable to locate the last titled owner we would require a court order awarding you ownership of the vehicle along with a completed <u>SFN 2872 Application for Certificate of Title</u> form, a \$5.00 title fee, excise tax in the amount of 5% of the fair market value and registration fee will be due.
- If the vehicle does not have a title record ND Highway Patrol must inspect the vehicle to verify the VIN. The completed <u>SFN 2486 Certificate of Vehicle</u> <u>Inspection</u> form must be submitted along with an <u>SFN 2872 Application for</u> <u>Certificate of Title</u>, a notarized <u>SFN 2888 Seller's Certificate and Vehicle Bill of</u> <u>Sale</u> form, and a notarized Statement of Fact from the applicant. \$5.00 title fee, taxes in the amount of 5% of the fair market value, registration fees if the vehicle is roadworthy, and \$1.50 abandoned disposal fee are due.

When no record of a previous title is found, the division will check the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) computer to ensure that the vehicle is not listed as a stolen vehicle.
