

Special Mobile Equipment

What type of vehicle is considered Special Mobile Equipment?

- Special Mobile Equipment would be any vehicle not designed or used primarily for the transportation of persons or property and only incidentally operated or moved on the highway.
- Special mobile equipment of legal size and weight may operate without payment of registration or permit fees. <http://www.nd.gov/ndhp/pdf/permits/handbook.pdf>
- Special mobile equipment exceeding legal size or weight may operate on single trip permits which are issued by the North Dakota State Highway Patrol. <http://www.nd.gov/ndhp/permits/permits.html>
- Examples: Truck cranes
 - Work over rigs
 - Mobile Offices which do not contain sleeping quarters
 - Construction-equipped trailers
 - Concrete pump trucks
 - Self-propelled scrapers
 - Rubber-tired dozers and loaders
 - Coil tubing trucks
