

If A Voter Needs Assistance Marking A Ballot



If any voter is unable to mark his/her ballot because he or she cannot read or because of a disability, he or she has a right to be assisted by a person of his or her choosing, provided that person is not the voter's employer or union official.

If the voter requests, the Moderator will assign an inspector of elections (ballot clerk) to assist the voter in marking his/her ballot.



Notify the Moderator that a voter needs assistance

The person assisting the voter may not tell the voter who to vote for!
