

Individual Language Learner Plan (ILLP) Training

Wednesday, August 19 – In Person at EVIT

The ILLP training will be offered in person on **Wednesday, August 19** in the Auditorium of the East Valley Institute of Technology (EVIT) from 10:00AM-12:00PM. EVIT is located at 1601 West Main Street, Mesa, Arizona. Please note that both this training and the August 18 webinar will cover the same material.

As English language learners become proficient and are reclassified, there will be fewer of them to be instructed in English Language Development (ELD) in an SEI classroom.

The method of delivery of this ELD instruction for those ELLs in the mainstream classroom will be through the use of an ILLP, or Individual Language Learner Plan.

Guidance will be given on the preparation and the implementation of the ILLP for English language learners in the mainstream classroom. Attachment A, enriched with sample activities in the content areas of math, science and social studies, will be discussed. These samples will address the elementary, middle, and high school levels.
